- 2. What are some of the specific aspects to look for in the review reports that indicate an issue which could be addressed by the FB?
- 3. Should the FB elaborate indicators or criteria to help the branch in determining whether to offer facilitation and advice to a Party?
- 4. Should the Committee continue its dialogue with lead reviewers, and if so:
  - a. What should be the role of the FB and the focus of the dialogue?
  - b. Should the practice continue that members of the bureau be invited to attend lead reviewers' meetings?
