2. Mandate and previous work

- **Article 10.5 of the Paris Agreement** notes that *“accelerating, encouraging and enabling innovation is critical for an effective, long-term global response to climate change...”*
- **COP 21 requested** TEC and CTCN, in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement, to undertake further work on technology RD&D

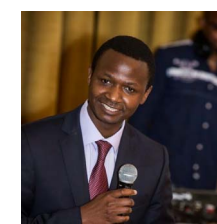

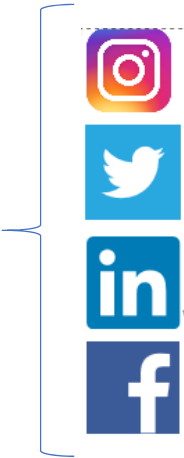
